The Purpose of the Meeting: The Department of Environmental finds it necessary to propose fee increases to offset Consumer Price Index increases and employee Cost of Living Adjustments, in the programs areas such as: Certified Unified Program Agency (CUPA), Local Oversight Program (LOP), Food Facility Sanitation, Public Pools/Spas, Solid & Medical Waste, and Land Use.

The Department will present supporting documentation for the proposed fee increases, and receive public input regarding the impact of the proposals. The proposal for FY 2007-08 will recommend an increase of 4%. In subsequent years for FY's 08-09 and 09-

10, a proposal will be made to the Board of Supervisors recommending a 1% plus a percentage based on County approved Cost of Living Adjustments for employees.
