LEA Findings per §21665(c): The LEA finds that the proposed changes are consistent with all CEQA documents; is acceptable and consistent with all state minimum standards; and the proposed changes do not conflict with the existing solid waste facility permit (SWFP).

Description of Proposed Changes: Updating of the Facility's Transfer/Processing Report (TPR) to: 1) Add detailed description on the storage and transfer operations of source-separated and/or recovered food wastes proposed at the facility; 2) Update the Facility Floor Plan; 3) Add Odor Impact Minimization Plan as Appendix J to the TPR; 4) Update Appendix E - Emergency Procedures and Contingency Plan.

This update was required by the LEA following the 5-year review of documents required by Section 21675, Title 27, of the California Code of Regulations.
