Introduction

Please be advised that the Alameda County Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and approved a Report of Facility Information (RFI) Amendment for the Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) of Vasco Road Landfill (VRL). The LEA is certified by the California Department of Resources Recovery and Recycling (CalRecycle) to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste facilities within the Alameda County.

Description of project and LEA's determination

The Project Applicant, Republic Services Vasco Road, LLC, currently operates a solid waste facility on 323 permitted acres area allowing 246 acres for disposal. This facility is located at 4001 North Vasco Road, Livermore, CA 94550. On September 3, 2014, the LEA received from VRL, a SWFP application package to amend the RFI requesting to update the document to:

- Update the RFI pursuant to the approval of using combined Biosolids and Treated Auto Shredder Waste (TASW) as Alternative Daily Cover (ADC) at the facility.
- Update the Joint Technical Document (JTD) to include the use of combined Biosolids and TASW as ADC at the facility.
- Update the JTD to include the Landfill Gas-To-Energy (LFGTE) facility and the new retaining wall at the entrance to the facility.

No other changes to the SWFP are under consideration at this time. The LEA finds that the proposed changes are consistent with the California State Minimum Standards, and all applicable certified and/or adopted California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) documents. The proposed changes do not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current SWFP. The LEA approved the RFI amendment on October 2, 2014.
