

THE IMPROVEMENTS OF HAVILAND AVENUE FROM GROVE WAY TO WILLOW AVENUE

Project Description

This sidewalk improvement project on Haviland Avenue will improve pedestrian access in the area and also to and from Cherryland Elementary School. The project includes constructing concrete curbs, gutters, and sidewalks, pavement reconstruction, installing a storm drain system, and planting street trees. The project limits are Haviland Avenue between Grove Way and Willow Avenue.

Project Objective

- To improve accessibility and safety for all roadway users, especially pedestrians.



Project Features

- Project length: 700± feet
- Construction of curb, gutter and sidewalk from Grove Way to Willow Ave.
- Provide adequate street width for on-street parking and two-way traffic, so vehicles will no longer need to park within the walkway area and block pedestrian access.
- Installation of storm drain system to improve drainage.
- Planting of street trees to beautify the area and create a more pleasant walking environment and traffic calming effect.
